I have made it clear to the health board that I expect to see improvements in performance across the health board, not just in orthopaedics. I expect the health board to continue to work closely with the Planned Care Programme to develop a sustainable service. To support this, the Welsh Government has allocated an additional sum of £11.09 million to Betsi Cadwaladr UHB.
