Email sent from Welsh Government to all Local Authorities in Wales on 31st January 2018

Dear Director of Education,

I am writing to inform you of your 2018-19 post-16 allocations for Sixth Forms and Adult Community Learning (ACL).

Sixth Form Allocations

I am pleased to confirm that for 2018-19, we have been able to increase the unit rate of funding by 1.0 per cent across the post-16 sector.

Sixth Form allocations are detailed in the attached Annex A.

The allocations methodology is the same as in previous years, although for 2018-19 an updated 'average funding rate per learner' has been calculated for each Local Authority. This average funding rate is multiplied by a predicted headcount to give an 'allocation before uplifts' and to this the Welsh Medium, Sparsity and Deprivation uplifts are added, to give an overall Local Authority allocation.

Headcount predictions

The headcount predictions have been calculated in the same way as previous years, following the methodology that was agreed with the ADEW Directors group.

Average Funding Rate per learner

A new average funding rate has been calculated for the 2018-19 allocations based on the 2015/16 PLASC return. The mix of programmes delivered in 20115/16 has been matched to the 20117/18 programme values to give an average rate per learner for each Local Authority. This value has then been increased by 1.0%.

Deprivation uplift

For 2018-19, the deprivation uplift has been pro-rated in line with the variance from the 2017-18 allocation.

The methodology for the deployment of the deprivation uplift will be reviewed again in the future, as the Post-16 Planning and Funding Framework moves forward and new data becomes available.

Sparsity uplift

Sparsity allocations have been maintained at the same level as in 2017-18. Again, the methodology for the deployment of the uplift will be reviewed in the future.

Welsh Medium

Whilst the intention was to review all categorisations for 2018/19, this has not been possible. Therefore, Welsh Medium allowances have been maintained at the same level as in 2017/18 whilst a review of the methodology takes place in readiness for 2019/20.

The calculations of learner numbers and your individual uplift values will be detailed in your individual Local Authority Annex B, which will be sent to you under separate cover.

Local Authority ACL provision

ACL provision has been maintained at the same level as 2017/18.

Local Authorities should use the additional funding to support additional provision in the priority areas of Essential Skills, English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) and Digital Literacy.

ACL allocations are detailed in the attached Annex C.

2019-20 Allocations

The Annex B that accompanies this letter includes indicative allocations for 2019-20 based on the current data set that we hold. The data used to inform these indicative allocations will be updated once we receive your latest PLASC collections, so these indicative allocations should be used as a guide only. You will also be aware that the published Post-16 budget is due to decrease by £9.8m in 2019-20 and consideration of how this reduction will be applied has not been included in the indicative allocations shown.
