Dear Director, Mr Speed,

I am writing with regards to numerous concerns that have been raised with me about the alleged intention of your organisation to remove a telephone box from Cwm Penmachno, Conwy.

The facility under consideration is situated at the end of Machno Terrace, and directly opposite No. 6 Glanaber Terrace. Please find enclosed a photo and map showing the location.

As you will see, the phone box is located at the end of the Machno Valley, and within a thriving community. Indeed, I cannot but applaud the residents' efforts to improve the village over recent years, and as such am pleased to be able to write in aid of their tireless work, by highlighting serious concerns about the proposed closure of the phone box.

Whilst I appreciate that BT might look at usage as a means of establishing whether a facility should be closed, in this instance to do so would be unreasonable given my understanding that the phone box is out of use.

The threat posed by the phone being unusable and potentially removed is apparent when considering that there is no mobile signal in the valley. Alongside this, the community is seeing an increasing number of visitors because of its appeal as a walking destination, the home of Go Below, and incorporation into the Snowdonia Slate Trail. As such, it is fact that there will be countless individuals caught up in the valley with no means of making a call in an emergency. More so, I believe that a number of premises in Cwm Penmachno are without a landline too, so the removal of the phone really could result in an extremely serious emergency not being addressed promptly or in time.
