Dear Janet

Thank you for your letter of 9 March regarding yellow lines on the north bound A470 at Benarth Court in Glan Conwy.

Regarding your question about where displaced vehicles will be parked, the length of the restriction proposed has been kept to a minimum in order to reduce the numbers of spaces lost. However, it must be pointed out that road safety takes priority over such issues.

Consideration has not been given to providing yellow lines on the southbound side of the trunk road in the area. This current piece of work only aims to investigate visibility problems for vehicles exiting Benarth Court.

It is currently anticipated that there will be a formal consultation on the proposal towards Summer 2021, with the road markings being laid autumn / winter 2021 assuming no objections are received during the public consultation.

Please see the attached map which clearly shows the area the yellow lines will cover.
