The Welsh Government is currently updating the Setting Local Speed Limits in Wales guidance, to reflect its current policy including the national roll-out of [20mph speed limits](#) and to meet the ambitions highlighted in [Llwybr Newydd: the Wales Transport Strategy 2021](#). The new guidance will be published later this year and the work may see a change in the criteria for lower speed limits in Wales.
